



**McDonald's Dollar Menu changes seen ahead**

Los Angeles: McDonald's Corp will likely raise the price of its flagship Dollar Menu item, the Double Cheeseburger, and replace it with a new double hamburger with one slice of cheese, analysts said. "The double cheeseburger will likely rise from 99 cents to \$1.19, while a new product, called 'McDouble,' will be a double hamburger with one slice of cheese," JP Morgan analyst John Ivankoe said in a client note on Friday. McDonald's Double Cheeseburger has two beef patties and two slices of cheese. The new McDouble would be different in that it would have only one slice of cheese. McDonald's executives said on the company's October 22 earnings conference call that they were testing products and that a decision would be made "soon."
